



## UNIFORM DRESS CODE

- Sacred Heart's dress code is determined by the pastor on the recommendation of the School Board and the principal.
- Students should come to and leave school in complete uniform unless otherwise indicated by the school.
- Sacred Heart administration reserves the right to determine the appropriate clothing for Mass attendance and field trips.
- A uniform violation form will be issued for all other inappropriate and non-uniform compliance violations. An accumulation of three violations per quarter will result in a demerit with the exception of a jumper/skirt/skort/short length violation. After two length violations, slacks must be worn for the remainder of the year. Parents' cooperation in helping us to attain these goals is imperative.

### Uniform/Grooming Policy

- Hair
  - Neat, clean, conservatively styled and well groomed, extreme hair styles are not permitted.
  - Boy's hair will be no longer than below the ear and off the collar.
  - Dying, tinting or painting is not allowed for girls or boys.
- Jewelry
  - Small ring, wristwatch
  - Small post earrings for pierced ears worn in both ears
  - No dangling or large earrings
  - Boys may not wear earrings
- Shoes
  - Dress/street shoes with rubber or leather soles for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades with pants, jumpers, skirts or skorts.
  - Gym shoes may be worn with the uniform shorts for all grades.
  - Gym shoes are to be worn in gym class only for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades.
  - Kindergarten students may wear gym shoes with the school uniform.
  - Snow or rain boots may be worn to and from school, but never in the classroom.
- Shirts and blouses are to be tucked in at all times, sleeves are not to be rolled.
- Belts are to be worn through loops on pants and shorts. No suspenders are allowed.
- Socks must be worn at all times.
- Coats, jackets and non-uniform sweaters/sweatshirts may not be worn in the classrooms. The approved sweatshirt is part of the uniform for all grades and should be used during the cold months.
- Gym uniforms are mandatory for grades 6 through 8. These may be ordered through the school office in the summer.
- Out of uniform days will be announced. The type of clothing to be worn on these special days will be specified. If it is a dress-up day, no jeans, T-shirts, shorts or gym shoes may be worn.



## Uniform Regulations for Girls

- Grades K-4: Uniform plaid jumper no shorter than the knee can be worn year round.
  - Pants may be worn under the skirt when students are outside from October 1 to April 30.
  - Navy blue uniform pants may be worn by girls all year.
  - Navy blue uniform shorts may be worn by girls until September 30 and beginning on May 1, or at the discretion of the principal. Shorts must come to the knee.
- Grades 5-8: Uniform skirt or skort can be worn year round.
  - Navy blue uniform pants may be worn by girls all year.
  - Navy blue uniform shorts may be worn by girls until September 30 and beginning on May 1, or at the discretion of the principal. Shorts must come to the knee.
- Girls K-8
  - Blouse/shirt
    - White or red, short or long-sleeved collared blouse
    - White or red turtleneck shirt
    - White or red knit polo shirt
  - Navy blue, hunter green or white socks or tights
  - School approved sweatshirt & navy blue cardigan sweaters

## Uniform Regulations for Boys Grades K-8

- Navy blue uniform pants can be worn year round
- Navy blue uniform shorts may be worn until September 30 and beginning on May 1 or at discretion of principal.
- Short length may not be shorter than the kneecap but not below.
- Navy blue or white socks
- Shirts
  - White or red, short or long-sleeved collared shirt
  - White or red turtleneck shirt
  - White or red knit polo shirt
- School approved sweatshirt & navy blue cardigan sweater
